An electronic submission form will be emailed to you at the end of the production for you to share how you met the Do Your Part Requirements.

The deposit will be retained and cashed by The Majestic if you DO NOT fulfill any part of your commitment as outlined. Remember – we want your HELP more than your MONEY!

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide basic wardrobe pieces. Examples of basic items include underclothes such as camis, tank top, tights, shorts, black or khaki pants, white button-down shirts, shoes such as black flats or boys dress shoes. These are items you likely have in your closets for school, events etc. Failure to provide these base items, and if The Majestic has to provide these base items, your Do Your Part deposit will not be returned.
- Sell/Purchase at least one ad in the Show Playbill (includes personal messages from family members \$10 - \$75. Due by: January 11, 2025
- Provide refreshments for the concession table at performances (baked or store bought, individually wrapped please).
- Active Promotion of our show: hanging posters, handing out cards, flyers etc. You will be asked to list at least 4 ways you promoted the show / locations you hung posters.
- Volunteering to help with either: <u>LOAD IN of tech week</u> OR <u>Set Build / Painting</u> OR <u>Load Out after the performance</u>. (at least one of these 3 options is required)
- Helping with costumes, ushering and backstage is also needed but not required.
